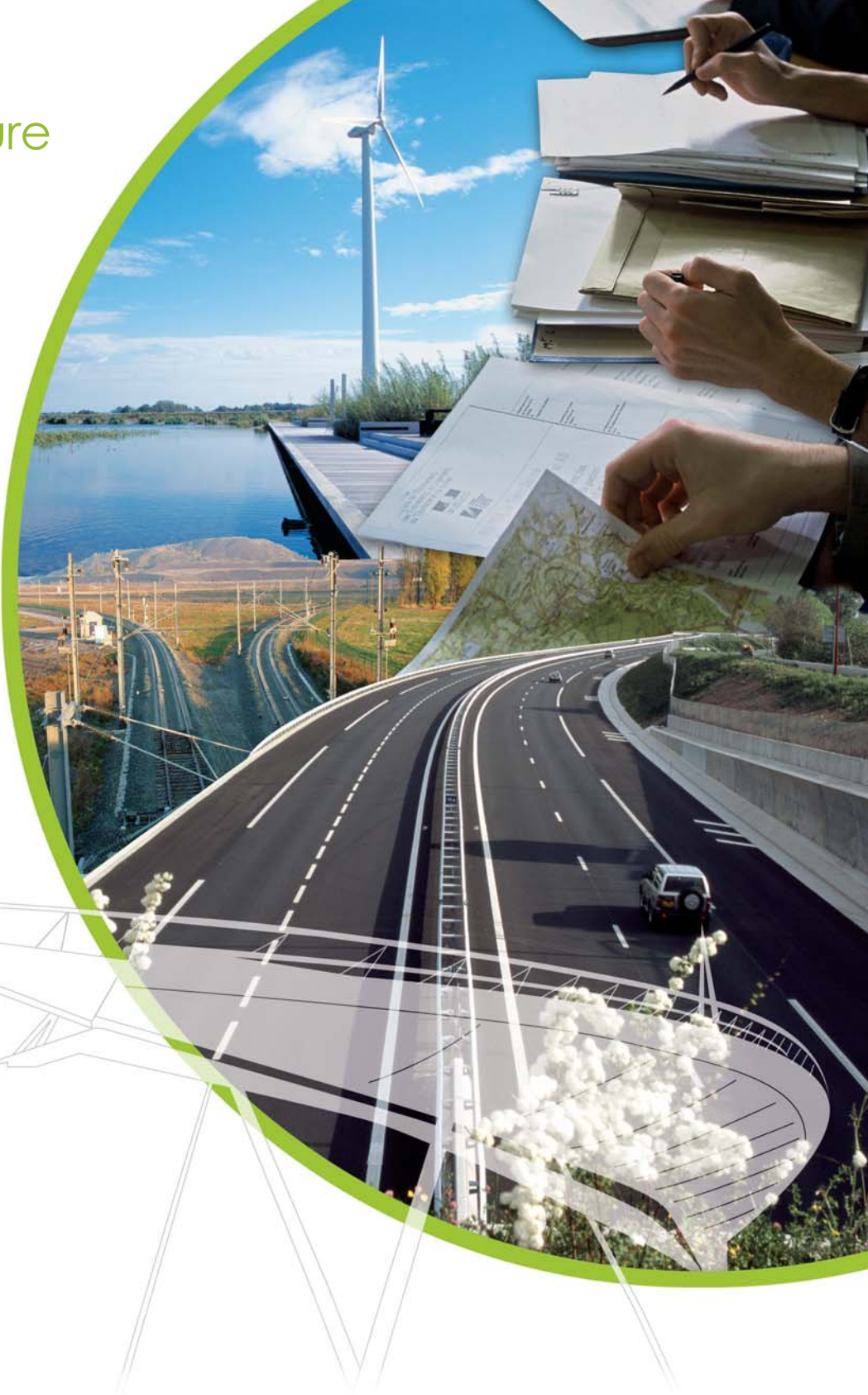


Building the future

Egis relies on its three core businesses:

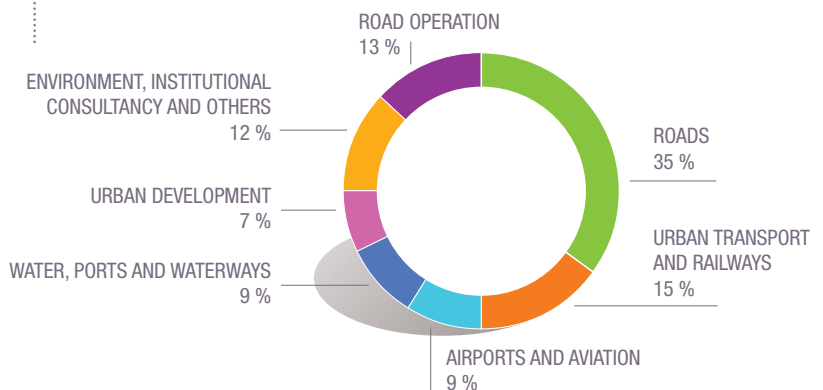
- Infrastructures and systems engineering (designing),

Through its regional and international locations it can respond directly to the expectations of its clients, taking their human, economic and environmental context into consideration.

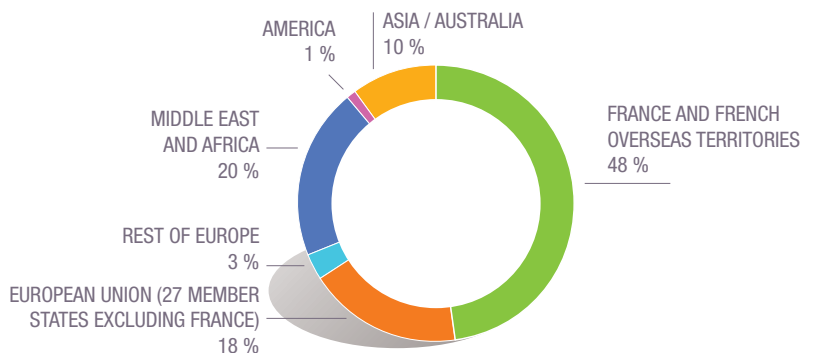
Egis in figures (2008)

Sales breakdown by activity

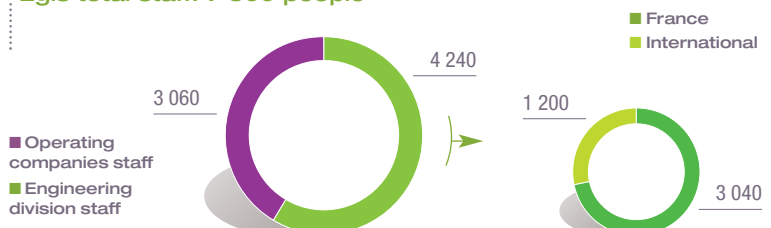


Sales breakdown by geographical zone

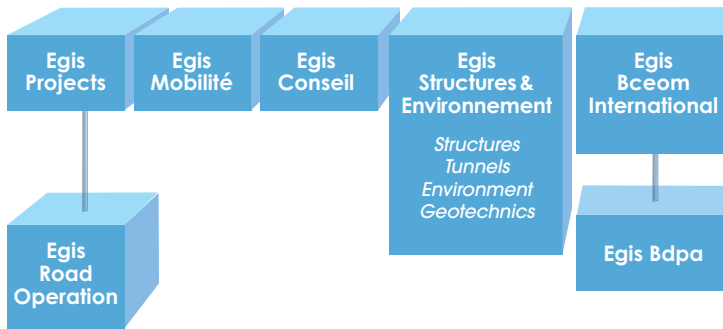




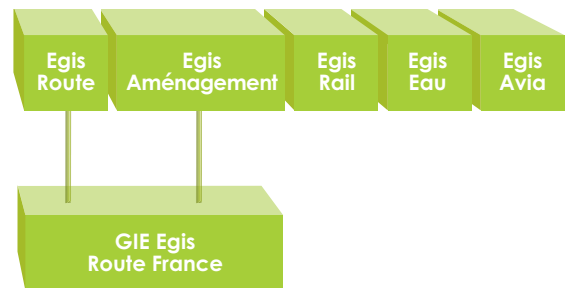
Egis' ambitions as follow:
